Our Interventionist will plan, execute, and track interventions and support classroom teachers in providing targeted assistance (during intervention blocks and after school) to a selected group of students. Our Interventionist will support classroom teachers to ensure every moment is maximized and gaps are closed within that day.

The Interventionist will have the following key responsibilities.

- Planning, executing and tracking intervention for targeted students.
- Providing small group instruction, reteaches, and additional practice for students in math, science, and reading/writing.
- Providing one on one reteaches, intervention, and remediation.
- Working in small groups and one on one with students on our intervention platforms (Reading Plus, Lexia Core, and Wowzers).
- Using data from intervention platforms and NWEA Map to plan intervention and set goals for individual students.
- Setting and maintaining high expectations for behavior in classrooms and hallways.
- Supporting with small group instruction, reading intervention, and providing one on one support for struggling learners.
- Communicating effectively with students, families, and colleagues;
- Responding to family concerns promptly and effectively;
- Participating actively when needed in department meetings, faculty meetings, and other meetings;
- Providing consistent rewards and/or consequences for student behavior to ensure that students observe the School's core values, high expectations, and strict code of conduct;
- Performing other related duties as requested and assigned.
